## **Industrial Sites by County**

The Oklahoma Department of Commerce has been actively engaged in working with communities to develop and market industrial sites statewide through four specific programs. Per legislation, OK Commerce received a portion of federal American Rescue Act (ARPA) and state allocated Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity (PREP) funds to enhance infrastructure within industrial sites across the state. OK Commerce also received state unallocated PREP funds to allow communities to competitively bid to receive a portion of the funds for industrial site enhancement. Additionally, OK Commerce markets industrial sites across the state on the Locate OK platform, a website designed to promote available land. The intent of these programs is to enhance site readiness so that the state remains internationally competitive for business expansion and relocation opportunities. To be internationally competitive, the state must have shovel ready sites along with workforce and housing to support growth. The following is a list of counties that have industrial site development/enhancement or are actively marketing available sites.
