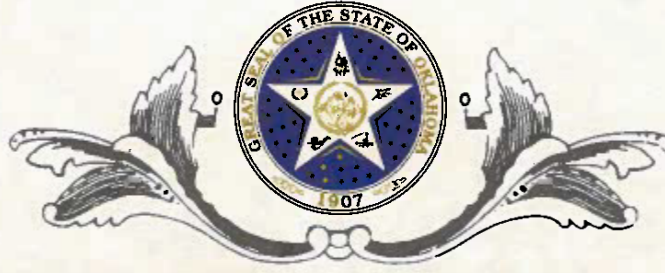

Proclamation

Whereas, the Oklahoma Housing Finance Agency (OHFA) began its service to the public in 1976, assisting more than 3,200 Oklahoma families through rental assistance in its first year alone; and

Whereas, for nearly five decades, OHFA has served as a statewide leader in affordable housing solutions, providing rental assistance, homebuyer down payment assistance, and housing development financing to benefit Oklahomans in all 77 counties; and

Whereas, access to safe, stable, and affordable housing is essential to the well-being of Oklahoma families and to the economic strength of communities across our state; and

Whereas, OHFA has continued to expand its impact through modern initiatives such as the Oklahoma Housing Stability Program, the largest state housing investment in Oklahoma history; and

Whereas, OHFA remains guided by its mission of “providing housing resources with an eagerness to serve,” reflecting a long-standing commitment to helping Oklahoma families achieve housing stability and opportunity; and

Whereas, the celebration of OHFA’s 50th anniversary recognizes both the agency’s historic achievements and its continued dedication to innovative housing solutions that strengthen the State of Oklahoma;

Now Therefore, I, Governor J. Kevin Stitt, do hereby proclaim May 13th, 2026, as

“Oklahoma Housing Finance Agency Day”

in the State of Oklahoma
